Brand History

In 1922, Franz Kugler's Munich tavern was overwhelmed with 13,000 cyclists. Afraid he'd run out of beer, he mixed his lager with lemonade and called it "Radler," the German word for cyclist. The Radler soon inspired other beer mixtures like the Shandy.

A traditional shandy is beer mixed with a little something extra, and Leinenkugel's® Grapefruit Shandy is our take on this tradition.

Each batch begins with our traditional Weiss beer. Then we mix it with the flavor of natural white grapefruit.

Ingredients

Malts: Pale and Wheat
Hops: Cluster
Special: Natural white grapefruit flavor

IBU: 11 | ABV: 4.2%



Sensory Experience

A – Champagne yellow with a slightly off-white foam

A – Freshly sliced grapefruit dominates the aroma with notes of toasted bread

T – Bready wheat twang and juicy citrus with a pleasantly tart bitterness that balances the malty sweetness

M – Medium-light in body and slightly creamy

F – Sweet and juicy citrus up front that fades to a refreshing subtle dryness

- Summer salads with vinaigrette dressing
- Citrus marinated grilled shrimp
- Blueberry-lemon cheesecake bars
